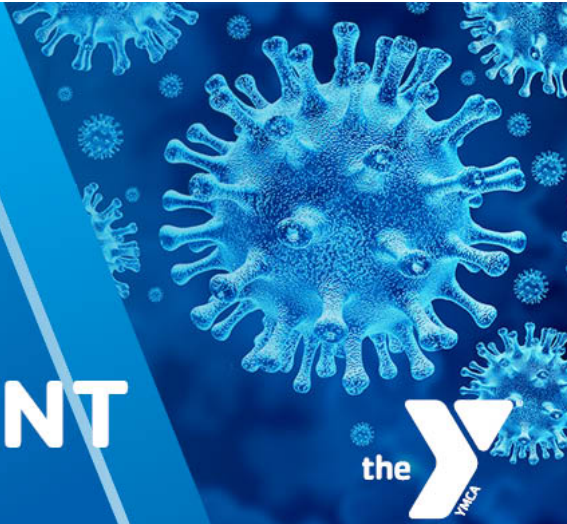

COVID-19 UPDATE GOVERNOR EVERS' EMERGENCY MANDATE #3

On October 6th, Governor Evers issued emergency order #3 limiting public gatherings to no more than 25% of an indoor room's occupancy. This order went into effect yesterday at 8:00am (October 8th) and will remain until November 6th.

So what does this mean for the Y and our operations?

At this time - nothing.

As part of our COVID-19 reopening plans, the YMCA leadership determined safe individual room and overall building capacity limitations. Since June 1st, our building occupancy has been and continues to be restricted to approximately 14%. This far outperforms the state mandate as well as recommendations set forth by the CDC and WEDC.

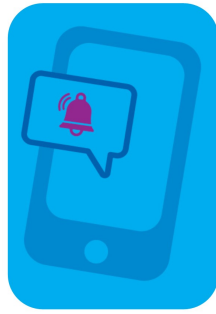
YOUR INPUT IS NEEDED
